Certificate of immunization in cases of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (vaccine passport)

The National Communicable Diseases Commission has issued the notification regarding the issuance of a certificate of immunization in case of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) B.E. 2564 (2021) and the notification regarding a form of a certificate of immunization in case of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) B.E. 2564 (2021). By issuing the certificate of immunization in case of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) to the persons who are vaccinated to against COVID 19, and such vaccine must be registered in Thailand or certified by the World Health Organization (WHO) and must have the signature of the Director-General of the Department of Disease Control or the person assigned by the Director-General of the Department of Disease Control to issue certification documents with the seal of the agency of the person who issued the certificate. The benefit of this certificate are the international communicable disease prevention and international traveling. This certificate will be issued to individuals only, can not to be shared together in group and separate certificates shall be issued for children. And has a fee of 50 baht per time. However, such notifications are effective from 16 April B.E. 2564 (2021) onwards.
