The Revenue Department encourages government and private sectors to drive Thailand's Digital Tax Ecosystem towards 100% digitalization.

Mr. Lavaron Sangsnit, Director-General of the Revenue Department, revealed that “The Revenue Department has been advancing the electronic tax system for a while, and today is another day that is an important step in the system development of electronic taxation to facilitate the implementation of tax management for entrepreneurs. The Revenue Department has developed a new Digital Tax Ecosystem in taxation operations by introducing “Service Providers” to be an important role in enhancing tax management for seamless transfer to electronic systems, which will lead to a complete digital transformation of tax transactions by B.E. 2571 (2028).” The Revenue Department has created an incentive to transfer into the electronic system by creating a Digital Tax Ecosystem that benefits entrepreneurs' businesses, such as not having to store documents in the form of paper and fast tax refunds, etc. In addition, The Revenue Department has also provided tax benefits with 2 times deduction for investment in electronic systems and for service fees paid to Service Providers.
