Draft of the Ministerial Regulation Prescribing criteria and rates for receiving unemployment benefits

On 6 May 2025, the Cabinet approved the draft ministerial regulation specifying the criteria and rates of unemployment compensation benefits (No. ..) B.E. The key amendment is an increase in the unemployment compensation rate for those terminated from employment, raising it from the original rate of 50% to 60% of daily wages. This aims to alleviate the cost of living burden for insured persons in line with current economic conditions, as proposed by the Ministry of Labour. The draft has already reviewed by the Office of the Council of State.
